Mis Approaching Trial—His Complicity in the Assassination—New Proofs in Possession of the Government.

WASHINGTON, July 9, 1865. Now that the conspiracy trial is over, and the sentences of the Military Commission are executed, there will soon be some definite action concerning the trial of Jefferson Davis. If it should be determined to try him for treason, the proceedings will, of ourse, take place before a civil 'tribunal; but, from present indications, it is more probable that he will be tried by a Military Commission as the leader or institutor of the conspiracy, for, it is said in Government quarters, there are newly-discovered proofs against him in that connection.
