"Col Ingraham, Provost Marshall of the defenses north of the Potomac is engaged in taking testimony today, all of which fixes the assassination upon J Wilkes Booth."

April 15, 1865, 3 A.M.

"\$10,000 reward for assassin of the President offered by C C Augur, Major General, Commanding Department.

"Superintendent Richards and the Metropolitan Police were at work as soon as the assassination news reached them. At the request of Mr Richards, General Augur sent horses to mount the police."

April 28th, 1865.

Major General C C Augur has placed Col H H Wells in charge of all troops. District of Pauxent with headquarters at Port Tobacco."
