To Whome it may concern:

I We S. S. Dument, Proprietor and B. B. Brown Clerk of the Grand Avenue Hotel situated in the City of Enid and Oklahoma Territory declare that we and each of us know a Gentleman, who registered, as a guest at said Hotel on the 3rd day of Jan 1903 under the name of O. E. George. When on the 13th day of Jan 1903. he committed suicide in said Hotel by taking poison, and that we have this day been shown by Mr. J. L. Bates of Memphis Tenn. a small tin type plate and a photograph and say that the same are perfect pictures or likenesses in each and every part of the said O. E. George, the only difference being that George was older at the time of his death than when the pictures were taken. George declaring on his death bed that he was
