

Atzerot Captured.

BALTIMORE, Thursday, April 20, 1865.

A dispatch from Gen. E. B. Tyler, dated Relay House this evening, says:

"Sergeant Gammill of the 1st Delaware Cavalry, Captain Townsend's company, of my command, has just brought in George A. Atzerot, one of the assassins.

He has been identified by the detectives who have been pursuing him."
