

Following is an article from The Enid Wave, October, 13, 1902 telling about the death and burial of Robison.

In the County Clerk's office at Enid/<sup>the</sup>burial records were searched and it was found that John Walter Robison was buried October 10, 1902 in lot 44, block R..

The Enid Wave, June 1, 1903 says "the grave of Major Crump and Captain John Walter Robison, the only two confederate soldiers buried here were decorated just the same as the boys who wore the blue".
