"Miss Henrietta Irving, well known as an actress in Buffalo, entered the room of J. Wilkes Booth, at Sanwix Hall, last Friday, and attacked him with a dirk, cutting his face badly. She did not, however, succeed in inflicting a mortal wound. Failing in this, she retired to her own room and stabbed herself, not bad enough" to go dead", however.
