Booth. -- The following paragraph is taken from the Madison Courier of May 10, 1861:

"Miss Henrietta Irving, well known as an actress in Buffale, entered the room of J. Wilkes Booth, at Sanwix Hall, last Friday, and attacked him with a dirk, cutting his face badly. She did not, however, succeed in inflicting a mortal wound. Failing in this, she retired to her own room and stabbed herself, not bad enough to go dead", however. The cause was disappointed affection, or some little affair of that sort."
