For Defense of Her Mother

May 30, 1865 C.T.130

Testified that John Wilkes Booth was at their Washington house Friday 14th; that he mother was preparing to go to Surrattville and that the carriage was at the door; that Mr. Booth only staid a very few minutes.

Mrs. EMMA OFFUTT

Sister-in-law of Lloyd, the Tenant
of Mrs. Surratt at Surrattville.

May 17, 1865 C.T. Page 121.

Testified that Mrs. Surratt arrived at Mr. Loyd's, Surrattville about 4 o'clock on the afternoon of the 14th.

LOUIS J. WEICHMANN

May 13, 1865 C.T. Page 113

Testified that he hired a buggy at Howard's livery stable about 2:30 on April 14th and drove her to Surrattville the same day arriving there about 4:30 and that just before leaving the city that he saw Mr. Booth in the parlor and Mrs. Surratt was speaking with him.
