Chicago, April 18, 1865. - Editors Chicago Tribune:-- There is one fact which I think ought to be known. Last fall, while a member of the Sons of Liberty, in this city, I heard, and instantly reported to General Sweet, which reports were forwarded to the War Department, at Washington, a distinct proposition made to raise \$50,000 to send a man to Washington to assassinate President Lincoln, and I have not a particle of doubt the plan originated with, and was executed by the "Sons of Liberty."
